Foundation Classroom, National Board grant applications due December 12: The deadline for applications for Classroom and National Board Certification grants from the Education Minnesota Foundation for Excellence in Teaching and Learning is December 12. Classroom Grants are intended for Education Minnesota members who are licensed personnel working with students and wish to improve their practice and student achievement. This includes classroom teachers, guidance counselors and others who require a license to carry out their work with students.

You may request between \$500 and \$3,000 to purchase materials and services for use with students if those materials are part of projects you design now and implement in the 2015-16 school year.

Education Minnesota members who are licensed to teach and have three years of teaching/counseling experience are eligible to apply for a scholarship to help offset the costs to become a National Board Certified Teacher (NBCT). The Foundation will grant at least six scholarships up to \$1,000. Grants will be awarded in February 2015 and must be spent by the end of July 2016.
